

COVID-19 Return to Tennis Competition

Information for Players

From 22 June 2020 Tennis competition will be allowed to play following the easing of the COVID-19 restrictions by the Victoria State Government. Tennis can be delivered almost as it was pre COVID-19 except for social gatherings and large groups, as long as we are able to provide the right hygiene protocols and abide by social distancing rules.

The following information is provided for our players returning to competition.

Venue

- For the foreseeable future, the clubhouse will remain closed for social gathering, access to kitchen and showers, but toilets will be open.
- All high touch surfaces are disinfected after every competition for your safety
- No equipment will be available for use.
- Tennis balls will be provided.
- Access to toilets will be via the west side of the clubhouse through the automatic sliding door.

Player information

- All player's names and a contact number will be recorded every week, to ensure we can track and trace your attendance should it be required (in relation to COVID-19)
- You will be required to sign a player declaration at the start of the season to ensure you are aware of your obligations.
- You will be encouraged to use cashless payments(cards) or bring correct money, to reduce cash handling by convenors.
- You will need to record the time you arrive and leave for a competition
- Spectators are not allowed, unless you are a parent/the person responsible for a minor/child.
- You must provide your own equipment and bring your own drink bottle; the clubhouse kitchen will not be open.
- In the event you or anyone you have been in contact with has signs or symptoms of COVID-19 and has visited the Tennis Centre, please inform Tennis Centre Management asap.

Hygiene

- Hand sanitiser will be provided for each court, please use frequently before, during and at the end of play, especially after handling tennis balls.
- Signs and posters are around the courts and in toilets have been provided reminding you of hygiene protocols.
- If you have any signs of being unwell, you will be asked to leave and not allowed to take the court.
